- *Professional development* opportunities for faculty in grantsmanship;
  - Communicated with GGSE scholars regarding several opportunities for development
  - Communicated with UCSB Office of Research to explore additional opportunities
- *Publicity / Promotion* of research accomplishments, publications, & dissemination;
  - Communicated with UCSB Office of Research and also the UCSB Development Office – Foundations Division to share the scholarship in the GGSE, and list of previous foundation funding GGSE scholarship
  - GGSE included in the UCSB Office of Research presentation to the UC Regents
  - GGSE included in the UCSB Office of Research annual report
  - Worked with Communications Director to develop GGSE RO information sheet
- *Performance tracking & administration* for funded research proposals & awards;
