

Centrally Administered Fellowships for New Students

Chancellor's Fellowship

The Chancellor's Fellowship provides support for new doctoral students. Both domestic and international students are eligible. The package includes three years of full Graduate Division support, and two years of departmental support in the form of a 50% Teaching Assistant or 49% Graduate Student Researcher appointment plus the payment of nonresident tuition for international students. The Graduate Division will pay the balance of fees if the student is hired as a TA. This fellowship also comes with a guarantee of access to University housing for the first year.

Regents Special & Humanities Special Pre-Doctoral Fellowships

These fellowships are for new doctoral or M.F.A. students. Both domestic and international students are eligible. These packages include two years of full Graduate Division support, and two years of departmental support in the form of a 50% Teaching Assistant or 49% Graduate Student Researcher appointment plus the payment of nonresident tuition for international students. The Graduate Division will pay for the balance of fees if the student is hired as a TA. These fellowships also come with a guarantee of access to University housing for the first year.

Doctoral Scholars Fellowship

This diversity fellowship is reserved for incoming domestic doctoral or M.F.A. students. It includes a four-year package including shared support between the academic department, Graduate Division, and either the College of Engineering, the College of Letters and Science, or the Gevirtz Graduate School of Education. These fellowships come with a guarantee of access to University housing for the first year.

Eugene Cota-Robles Fellowship

This diversity fellowship is reserved for the most meritorious incoming domestic doctoral or M.F.A. students. In addition to a four-year financial package, the fellowship guarantees access to University-owned housing for the first year.

McNair Scholars Fellowship

This fellowship is reserved for incoming doctoral students who have completed the McNair Scholars Program. The multi-year funding package provides two years of full Graduate Division support and three years of departmental support in the form of a 50% Teaching Assistant or a 49% Graduate Student Researcher appointment. The Graduate Division will pay for the balance of fees after fee remission if the student is hired as a TA/RA. This fellowship also provides guaranteed access to University housing for the first year.

Dean's Fellowship

This fellowship provides one year of support. Departments nominate doctoral or M.F.A. students or academic master's students if the master's degree is the highest degree offered at UCSB in that department or program. Students may receive the fellowship twice during their academic careers, but must be re-nominated, as it is not an automatically renewable award. Nonresident tuition is not provided.

Graduate Opportunity Fellowship (GOF)

This diversity fellowship provides a stipend for the academic year, and payment of fees and health insurance. New and continuing domestic doctoral (or M.F.A.) students are eligible. Students may receive the fellowship twice during their academic careers, but must be re-nominated, as it is not an automatically renewable award. Nonresident tuition is not provided.
