The training will also offer practitioners and educators strategies to address weight prejudice and thin privilege within schools, universities, clinical settings, as well as society at large. The presentation will also highlight the importance of diversity considerations to include a perspective of Health at Every Size®, a common sense paradigm that does not rely on weight as barometer of health, for the practice of building an inclusive community in a workplace, educational setting, and among individuals.
